2012 Cabernet Sauvignon

Tasting Notes

Opens with aromas of blackberry, blueberry and ripe currants. Full-bodied flavors of dark chocolate, espresso and ripe raspberry are accented by vanilla and barrel spice notes. The palate finishes with fine-grained tannins and balanced acidity.

Production Notes

This 100% Cab was sourced from our two estate vineyards, balancing bright acidity with classic "Rocks" minerality. It was awarded Gold in the Walla Walla Valley Wine Competition in 2012

Vineyards

- Waliser Estate, Walla Walla Valley
- Yellow Jacket Estate, Walla Walla Valley

Winemaking

- Hand-harvested grapes
- Small lot fermentations in stainless steel tanks
- The cap was manually punched down twice a day
- The wine was blended and aged for 21 months in 30% new and 70% neutral French Oak barrels
- Malolactic fermentation
- Cross flow filtration prior to bottling

Vintage

- The 2012 season started out very typically, with mild weather during bud break and spring growth
- Bloom period was warm and consistent for great fruit development
- August temperatures were slightly cooler allowing for a longer hang-time with good yields.
