Blackberry - blueberry - ripe currants - dark chocolate - espresso - ripe raspberry - vanilla - barrel spice notes - fine-grained tannins - balanced acidity

A 100% varietal Cabernet Sauvignon from our own estates in the 'Rocks District' of Milton Freewater

Vineyards

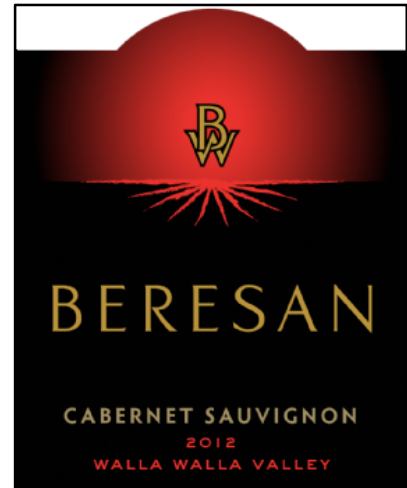
- Estate Waliser Vineyard - 'Rocks District' of Milton Freewater
- Estate Yellowjacket Vineyard - 'Rocks District' of Milton Freewater

Winemaking

- Hand harvested grapes
- Picked early in the morning
- Small lot fermentations in stainless steel tanks
- The cap was manually punched down twice a day
- The wine was aged for 14 months in French Oak barrels
- Cross flow filtration prior to bottling

Vintage

- Overall one of the warmest vintages on record
- Bud break started in early-mid April with bloom in early June, 1-2 weeks earlier than usual
- Warm summer temperatures allowed good ripening, with slightly smaller berries and thicker skins for deep, rich flavors and tannins
- Cool September temperatures slowed sugar accumulation and allowed long hang time for complex flavor development
- Harvest started on September 4th lasting through the end of October.
